

# The Brown Bin

Brown bin waste is composted

Do not place plastic bags in the brown bin.

Do not place biodegradable plastic bags in the brown bin.



Wrap food waste in two sheets of newspaper

or

use compostable bags, for example, those made from starch or maize, as food bin liners.

Acceptable bags will have an OK Compost Mark.

Please note:

Biodegradable and compostable are not the same thing. Biodegradable plastic bags are not compostable and can take hundreds of years to break down.

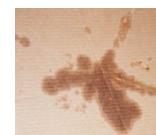


All cooked and raw food, including:

- Bread, pasta, rice
- Meat, fish, poultry, bones
- Fruit, vegetables
- Eggs, cheese, salads
- Tea bags, coffee grounds
- Leftover food
- Out-of-date food

(Always remove the food from the packaging before placing in the brown bin)

Paper napkins and paper towels  
Food soiled cardboard



Green garden waste, including:

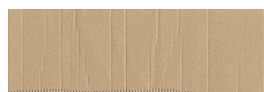
- Grass cuttings
- Leaves, weeds and mosses
- Dead plants and flowers
- Prunings, hedge cuttings



# The Green Bin

Green bin waste is recycled

- Newspaper
- Magazines
- Paper
- Cardboard
- Milk and juice cartons
- Plastic bottles and containers
- Food tins
- Drink cans

# The Grey Bin

Grey bin waste is dumped in a landfill.

It is not re-used or recycled.



- Each household should try to reduce the amount of waste in their grey bin.
- The easiest way to do this is to make sure that your waste is segregated properly.

Examples of non-recyclable and non-compostable items include:  
ashes... nappies... dirty plastic...  
toothpaste tubes... tin foil...  
non CFL-light bulbs... bathroom bin  
sanitary items... crisp packets...
