### **Tuam Regional Water Supply Scheme Extension to Headford**

#### **Emergency Works on Water mains supplying Galway City**

Galway County Council and Galway City Council are working closely together to increase the supply of water to Galway City from the County Councils Treatment Plant at Luimnagh. To facilitate this Galway County Council has instructed its Contractor for the above Scheme, Ward & Burke Construction, to carry out emergency works at Claregalway. As a consequence there will be severe disruption to traffic going through Claregalway as follows:

#### **Traffic Disruption on N17(Tuam Road) south of N18 junction.( i.e. turn off for Oranmore)**

At Claregalway from 10am on Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> may 2007 to 4pm on Thursday the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> of May 2007. North bound and South bound traffic will be affected.

#### **Water Supply Interruption**

Water supplies will be disrupted to the following areas:

Tuam Road from Claregalway, Mullacuttra, Kiniska, Claregalway, Cahernasilleany/Kiltroque, Cloonbiggen, Lakeview, Lydican. Cloon . Cloonacauneen . Pollkeen (Castlegar) Rockwood/Kiltullagh.

Water **may not** be available from 7pm on Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> May to 7am Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2007.
