Please note that Brian Conneely and Co Ltd, on behalf of GCC will carry out the following **Roadworks** from the 3-11-25.

Salmon Weir Bridge Pedestrian Crossing

The Salmon Weir Bridge Pedestrian Crossing Project entails the construction of a temporary pedestrian crossing across the R863 University Road at Galway Cathedral. This will be a toucan crossing (i.e. signal controlled crossing for use by walkers, wheelers and cyclists). It will connect the footway on University Road near Fisheries Field to Droichead an Dóchais and will improve safety for all road users.

Working hours

Most of the work will take place during normal working hours (8:00-18:00 Monday to Friday). Some of the works will have to take place at night to allow for lane closures at quieter traffic times. Works will be paused from before Christmas until January 6, 2026.

Traffic Management

GKTM will be employed to implement temporary traffic management systems in place for the duration of the works. Two-way vehicular traffic will be maintained during peak hours. Lane closures may be required at off-peak times. Signage will be erected to advise motorists of the works. Footways along Salmon Weir Bridge and University Road will be closed during certain periods. Signage will be erected on both sides of Salmon Weir Bridge, as necessary, to advise users of alternative, safe routes. Droichead an Dóchais will not be impacted by these works and will be open at all times.
