

### Important information for residents and businesses

Construction of the Bóthar Stiofáin Cycle Network Scheme has recommenced following Christmas. Works are substantially complete on Phase 1, and the eastern footpath is now open. We are now working on the western side of the road. **The next phase of works requires us to close the southbound lane of Bóthar Stiofáin for ten weeks, beginning on Wednesday 21 January.** This newsletter contains important information on accessing your home or business during this time.

### Temporary Southbound Lane Closure One-Way System – from January 21, 2026

- From **Wednesday 21 January**, works will be focused on Phase 2C, 2D and 2E as shown in the adjacent figure.
- To assist us in completing these works safely and without undue delay, a **24-hour Southbound Lane Closure** will be implemented between the Ragoon Road junction and the entrance to the Gateway Shopping Park. This will be in place from Wednesday 21 January for a period of **10 weeks**. Two-way traffic access between the Gateway Shopping Park and Western Distributor Road will be maintained.
- Signage will be in place to advise motorists for the duration of this lane closure.
- The one-way system will run from south to north from the entrance to the Gateway Shopping Park to Ragoon Road.
- **All vehicles exiting estates and homes onto Bóthar Stiofáin** will have to turn left and divert north to Ragoon Road and follow the temporary traffic diversion signs as per the below Temporary Diversion Plan (overleaf).
- **Access to affected homes** will be available via the northbound lane only i.e. entering Bóthar Stiofáin via the Western Distributor Road
- Works adjacent to properties fronting onto Bóthar Stiofáin will be coordinated in advance with individual households. Temporary arrangements will be put in place to facilitate driveway access and car parking as required.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained along Bóthar Stiofáin, with localised temporary diversions in place as required.
- We apologise of any inconvenience caused and appreciate your patience and continued cooperation.
