On behalf of Galway City Council and Jons Civil Engineering Ltd., we wish to thank residents and businesses for your cooperation and patience throughout the recent construction works on the Bóthar Stiofáin Cycle Network Scheme. Your support has been vital in the successful completion of all works to date.

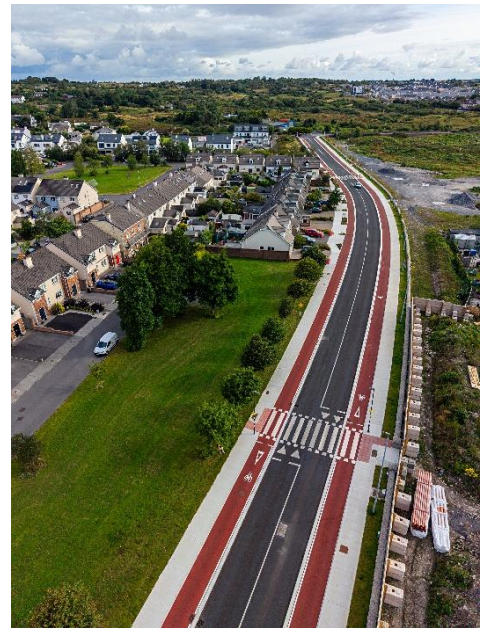
While the vast majority of works on this Scheme are now complete, Galway City Council has received feedback from the local community seeking changes to the junction at Lidl, linking Bóthar Stiofáin and the Gateway Shopping Park. Having considered this feedback, and following a joint technical review of this location, we will now carry out **improvement works for one week, starting from Monday September 7.**

Vehicular access between Bóthar Stiofáin and Gateway Shopping Park will be restricted for the duration of the works. Access will be maintained for walkers, wheelers and cyclists and access to all businesses be unaffected. This leaflet is to advise you of the temporary traffic management measures to facilitate the works.

This is the final phase of the significant construction works on this Scheme.

Gateway Junction Improvement Works

- From Monday September 7 until Friday September 11, works will be carried out during daytime hours. The purpose of these works is to reduce the height of the raised junction.
- In order for these works to be completed efficiently and in a safe fashion, vehicular access at this junction will be restricted on a 24-hour basis from 7:30 a.m. on Monday September 7 until 5 p.m. on Friday September 11. Access for walkers, wheelers and cyclists will be maintained.
- Motorists wishing to access Gateway Shopping Park from the Western Distributor Road are requested to proceed via the An Logán Roundabout Junction.
- Motorists wishing to access Gateway Shopping Park from the Ragoon Road are requested to proceed via the junction adjacent to the Gort Gréine estate. ***For more, please see the map overleaf.***
- Access to all businesses and schools will be facilitated throughout the works period, via these diversion routes.
- Temporary Traffic Management signs will be deployed on approach roads to the junction to assist motorists.
